

Admission procedure for Sunday-2-Sunday courses

1. All courses will be starting from Sunday, 1st October 2017.
2. Those who want to join 'Diploma in Life Management' are requested to attend FREE orientation programme on Sunday, 24th September 2017 at 10 am to understand the concept of Life Management and course content.
3. You can join Certificate Course in Computer anytime, as new batch will start first Sunday of every month.
4. Read details of all different courses, and talk to counselor at our office to clear all doubts.
5. You can contact personally on any working day.

6. Kindly note we do not provide any Hostel facility.
7. Interested person should apply on prescribed application form and deposit personally along with registration fee Rs. 1000/- by cash or cheque in favour of 'Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan' to reserve your admission.
8. Registration charges of Rs. 1000/- paid to reserve your admission, is not refundable, if you do not wish to join the course.
9. You have to pay first installment (less Rs. 1000/-), on or before beginning of the training programme i.e. Sunday, 1st October 2017.
10. You can pay fee by cash or by cheque (Delhi/NCR) in favour of '**Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan**'.
